Natural Gas Loop Lines

In the early days of Rocky Gas Co-Op history, our initial focus was the installation of the infrastructure and supply of natural gas to our customers as quickly as possible. Due to increased growth and demand over the last 40 years, system upgrades have become essential to maintain reliable and sustainable gas supply to our members.

For the past few years, we have been installing loop lines to meet demands during peak use periods. Loop lines provide increased supply and ensure adequate pressure.

This summer we are constructing our longest loop line project ever. In total we will install approximately 20 km of large pipe in the northeastern section of our franchise area to serve us now and well into the future.
